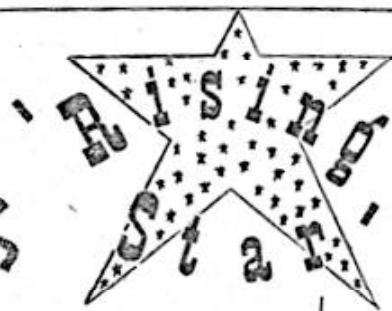

# JIMMY NEWMAN'S



A star finally coming into his own on the Dot recording label is Jimmy Newman. Jimmy has really hit it off with his latest disc, "A Fallen Star." And, we might add that we're mighty happy for him, because in our book he's the greatest!

Born in Louisiana, he remained there until just recently. While still a teenager, Jimmy played the guitar and sang country music with a local band. It wasn't until 1945, that Jimmy decided to make music his career. Jimmy signed with a small company and recorded original tunes. Today he records for Dot, and has had a number of successful hits, such as "Cry, Cry, Darling", "Come Back To Me", and "Day Dreaming". At least seventy-five percent of Jimmy's records have made the popularity charts of the trade magazines.

Jimmy was signed by WSM's Grand Ole Opry on August 4, 1956, and since that time he has been the favorite of most of the Opry goers.

ever he appears you must also feel this way.
